Common Exception Words

We have been learning to spell the common exception words **prove** and **improve**.

Grammar

We can use a **subordinating conjunction** to add extra information to a sentence. This extra bit of information is called a 'subordinate clause' and it only makes sense with the main sentence.

Subordinating conjunctions like **if**, **as**, **while**, **after**, **because** and **when** can all be used to join the extra bit of information to the main sentence.

Zain woke up with a fright **after** the loud bang.

She put on her coat **because** it was raining.
